
Be sure to keep an eye on the upcoming activities and plan to participate in as many as you can, there will be a lot of ways to get involved and show support!

IllIness Policy

Isolation: If a child becomes ill during the day, they are removed from the classroom and isolated in the Director's office to prevent the spread of illness.

Parent Notification: The parent is contacted immediately to pick up the child within 1 hour to prevent the child from staying at the center while sick.

Illness Report: The child is sent home with an illness report, likely detailing the symptoms and any necessary instructions for the parent.

Fever Policy: A child with a fever of 100°F or higher cannot return to the center without a doctor's note, ensuring the child has recovered enough to return safely.

Discharge Policy: If a child has noticeable nasal discharge (white, green, or yellow) throughout the day, they will be required to stay home for 24 hours and return only with a doctor's note, indicating that it is safe for them to interact with others.
